2. **GOAL:** Advocate for grade-appropriate, career-relevant education in Trinity County

OBJECTIVES:

- b. Review and recommend changes to existing school curricula: K-12 Curriculum- career portfolio
- c. Promote career path-based education and employment skills development
- d. Encourage business/employer inclusion through work - based learning programs, coursework development and process documentation
